All soccer games are played Mondays from 5:45-7:45pm at Park de la Cruz (3901 Landis St., SD 92105). Athletes need to be ready to do stretching/warm-ups at 5:30pm. Game times are 5:45pm & 6:45pm.

The 1st team listed wears yellow uniforms. The 2nd team listed wears green uniforms.

The soccer rules are the S4EA Soccer Rules which are basically indoor 6-a-side soccer rules. Based on the number of players showing up each week, the number of players on the field for each team may be increased or decreased in size by agreement of both coaches and referees. **Every player should get an opportunity to play at least one-half of every game. Volunteer players should be trying to get athletes as involved as possible since this is a sports program serving athletes with disabilities. We want the athletes to get a lot of touches on the ball and chances to score. Everyone can play hard, but remember, we are all here to have fun!**

Teams will play every other team in their division in a round robin format (B division double round robin). In the 2-team C division - the 2 teams will play each other every week at 5:45pm. Based on the final round robin standings, the teams will be seeded. 2 points are given for a win & 1 point is given for a tie in round robin play. The tie-breaker rules are 1) Head-to-head record among tied teams, 2) Goal differential among tied teams, 3) Goal differential among all teams. Ribbons will be awarded after each match on August 24 which concludes the Summer Soccer Season for Monday Practice/League Play/Playoffs. The S4EA Soccer Tournament is scheduled for Sunday August 30 at Morley Field in Balboa Park from 9am-4pm. Turn in your soccer uniform at the end of the soccer tournament (or end of soccer league play on August 24th).

In addition to registering with S4EA, athletes must also register with the City of San Diego on-line with SDRecConnect.com using code (132126) or register at the first practice with SDP&R-TRS.
