The Year-Round Sponsors have contributed at least \$5,000 since the start of S4EA in April 2007.

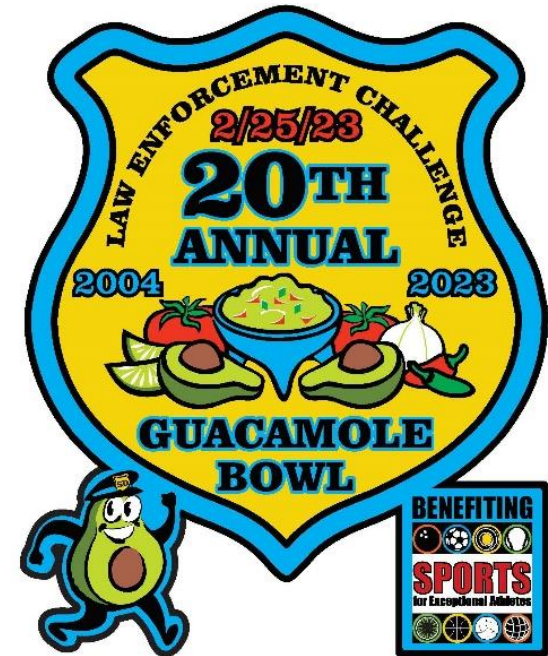

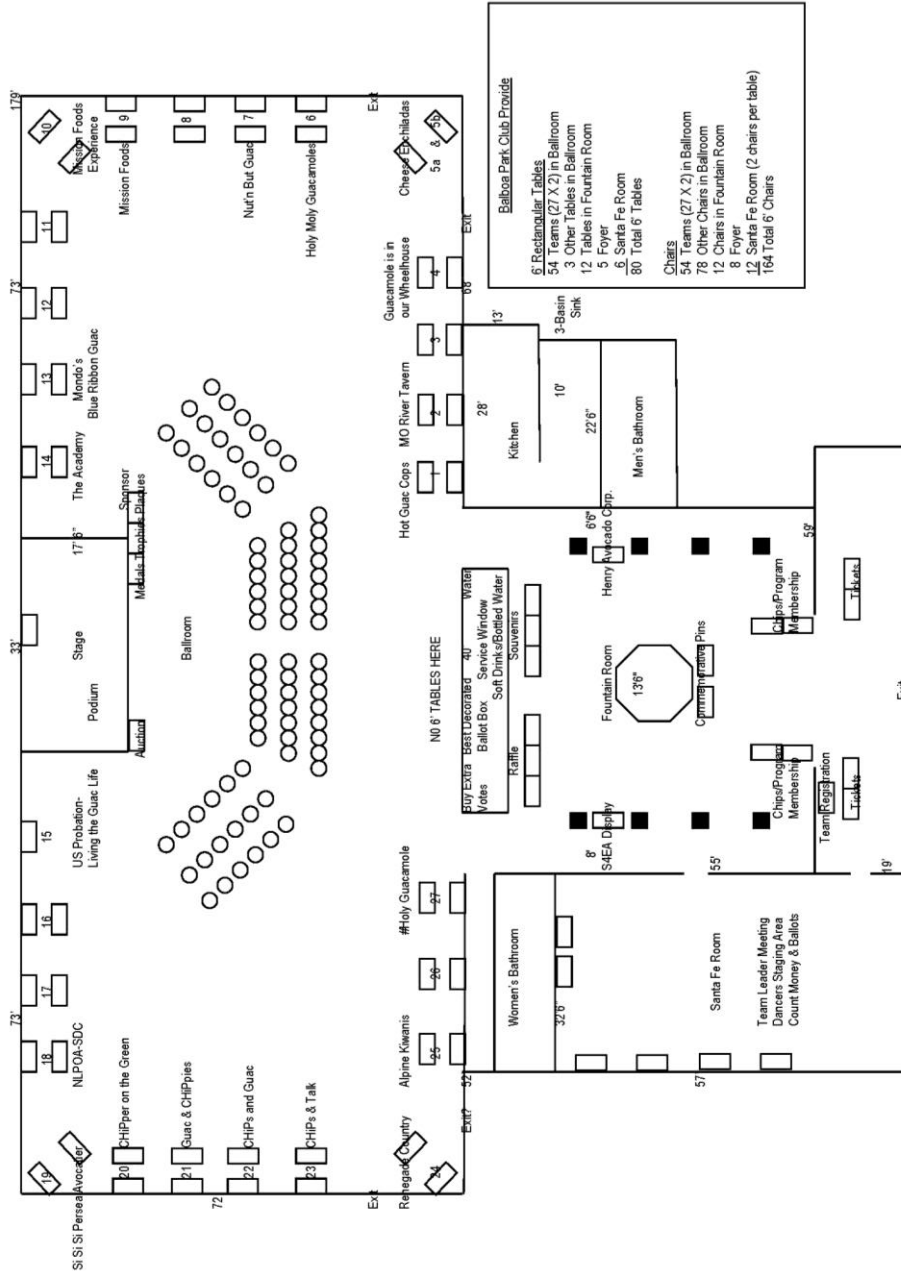

Prize Categories

Divisional "Cooking Medal" Awards: The top 3 teams in each division, decided by popular vote, will remake their recipe for the official judges for the final rounds. Cooking medals will be presented to the top 3 teams in each division.
