How to Keep Score:

- Each frame consists of 2 rolls (However, if get a strike on first roll, then the frame is over).
- Remove pins knocked down on first roll of each frame.
- Reset pins after each frame.
- Mark in left box number of pins knocked down on first roll.
- Mark in right box number of pins knocked down on second roll.
- In first frame – mark in big box the number of pins knocked down on both rolls.
- In subsequent frames – mark in big box the number of pins knocked down on both rolls plus number in big box of previous frame.
- If knock down all 10 pins on first roll, mark a strike (X) in left box. After getting a strike in frame, mark down 10 points plus number of pins knocked down in next 2 rolls plus number in big box of previous frame.
- If knock down rest of pins on second roll, mark a spare (/) in right box. After getting a spare in frame, mark down 10 points plus number of pins knocked down in first shot of next frame plus number in big box of previous frame.
- In 10th frame if get a spare, bowler gets 1 extra roll. Mark down 10 points plus number of pins knocked down on the 1 extra roll plus number in big box of 9th frame.
- In 10th frame if get a strike, bowler gets 2 extra rolls. Mark down 10 points plus number of pins knocked down in 2 extra rolls plus number in big box of 9th frame.
